Enclosed is Love Packages December 2023 newsletter. The testimony from South Africa, I know that a lot of you and I can relate to. It is an honor and privilege to be able to work for God in the literature ministry! However, we are human and we do get tired from picking up boxes, books, & etc., and being on our feet for hours at a time. This testimony stated that: "Literature PT can give one a good all over workout! The Bible can stretch our minds and muscles. "How true this is! Personally, I consider Harvest Seeds Ministry therapy for me! What joy it is to meet, work, and fellowship with God's people! 1 Corinthians 15:58 (NIV) "Therefore, my dear brothers, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain."

Since we started back, I try to schedule our work days on Thursdays when possible and schedule deliveries on the same day as our work day. If needed, I can schedule a delivery at other times and get someone else to help with the unloading. I am healing, but still depend on a cane for walking, and can't pick up heavy boxes yet. I am so thankful for all the help I have received from so many, in doing the work that normally I would do myself! And I am grateful for those of you who have scolded me, when I start to do or do something that I shouldn't do yet!

Just a reminder, Love Packages does not accept the choir sheets and choir books (musicals & etc.) and we have no where to donate to. <u>Hymns in good shape are accepted</u>. Also, Love Packages does not take

the Mission Mosaic, Mission Friends, RA, GA, or Acteen mission books. *They do accept the Awana materials*.

I have already scheduled our next <u>pallet loading which is Saturday</u>, <u>May 18</u>, <u>2024</u>. <u>We begin working at 7:00 AM</u>. Anyone is welcome to come and help. Our <u>last day to accept deliveries will be Wednesday</u>, <u>May 15</u>, <u>2024</u> and we will start <u>accepting deliveries again the week of June 17th</u>. Our children will be using our collection room for Vacation Bible School. The down time will give us time to clean out the room for the set up for Vacation Bible School, and then, set back up after Vacation Bible School.

In the attached December 2023 Love Packages' Newsletter under **BIBLE DRIVE**, Steve Schmidt emailed me an update on March 4, 2024. He said the following: "We have the \$120,000 now and have ordered the New Testaments! (375.000) of them. They should be here in 4-8 weeks. The free 45,000 full Bibles will be here shipped to us shortly. Thanks to everyone who prayed and gave toward this.

Any additional Bible money that comes in will be used to purchase other Bibles at an extremely discounted price. Some as much as 90% off from a Bible seller who is discontinuing some product lines".

India:

My name is Benia. I was born in an underdeveloped and uncivilized small village in Odisha, to a poor Hindu family. The first time I saw Christians was during Christmas time in my uncle's village. It was then that I faced the most difficult time of my life. I was battling with many questions. I had no money. That was when a Christian man invited me to celebrate Christmas with him in his village. I went with him to his village and while we were celebrating Christmas at the Church, certain Hindu extremists came and attacked us suddenly and we were forced to run away. It was cold, we had no warm clothes to cover ourselves and we became helpless and we started to cry. We tried to be silent because if the Hindus would hear our voices they would try to kill us. When the small children started to cry, we tried to cover their

mouths with our hands. It started getting colder and colder throughout the night. That night I prayed to God to save me. I knew then that Jesus was God. The next day, some brothers and I went back to the church to check the building and it was destroyed. After a couple more miracles in my life, I dedicated my life to Jesus Christ and made a decision to follow Jesus in ministry with my whole heart. Since that time our ministry has been greatly blessed through the distribution of free books. Our ministry has been able to grow spiritually as we study the Bible and books. The children's books have been very helpful in our orphanage and school in Orissa and we are able to improve the English vocabulary of the children as well as learn new Bible stories and lessons every time. Our church has been studying topics on prayer and Christian walk with God and from these books our eyes are being opened to newer revelations that God is revealing to His servants. Our ministry is grateful to God for all the free resources you have blessed us with, as we do not have the finances to purchase books. Our vision is to change the lives of people by bringing them from darkness to light.

South Africa:

Yesterday was a very long day. I was awake from 3 AM and on my feet all morning sorting through, categorizing and carrying, tons of Bibles and books. My muscles were aching by the end of the day.
